

Kevin's Story

Born January 18th, 1981, in Redwood city, California at Kaiser Hospital, and conceived by a striving Mother Gwendell Watts, Kevin Watts, was brought into this world.

Growing up seemed decent until his father abandon him and his mother. While Kevin's mum worked non faltering to not fall victim of government assistance, and his older brother was in and out of prison, Kevin had adopted a sort of Man-Child mentality at an early adolescent age.

Yet, Kevin always kept high goals and positive ambitions. But as life transpired pressure and turmail began to take toll on this young Man-Child soul. Seeking belongment, Kevin begun to affiliate with those whom shared his povertized environment.

Eventually he was sent to Texas to dislodge him from the abstract obstacles of destruction that lay ahead. Things somewhat became maintainable again. Kevin went to a private religious school, played sports and obtained gratifying grades. In his freshman year of High School, he was diagnosed with Emotional Stress Syndrome and later forced to drop out by his principles suggestions.

At 19 years old, Kevin became a father of an adorable little girl. Assisting the mother of his child with every fatherly fibber invested in him by his mum, and strove to provide a better living for his child as his mother always tried.

On March 1st 2002, the devastating event that has lock down Kevin until executed. Kevin's future has evaporated and was sentenced to death as society judged him blindly. All that was heard was that he was apprehended for tree counts of murder, kidnapping and sexual assault.

In spite of these charges, he withstood an absurd trial in the name of justice. A main witness testified that there were others, the victim testifying that he was not the shooter but yet, Kevin, was found guilty and condemned to lethal injection.

Kevin is to this day fighting for his life, fighting to prove he was unfairly judged, prosecuted and sentenced to death.

Not only did the judge have an already mind set on the case, but in the Texas Law, one must knowingly and intentionally commit their capital crime to even make the case call for capital punishment.

Yet Kevin was arrested and diagnosed highly sedated on various hallucinating drugs.

Convicting allegations

- 1) Finger print on murder weapon (and several others)
- 2) A letter containing gang affiliation and content (to slander and depict him as a terrorist)
- 3) Testimony of victim/ hostage (indicating his presence not murder)
- 4) Kevin's written confession.

Argument's in Kevin's favour

- 1) Disqualification of the mitigating specialist that was able to prove his incompetence childhood up brings. Abuse and that he was mentally dysfunctional.
- 2) Victim not indicating him as the killer and another witness testifying to 3 others involved.
- 3) Dawson versus Delaware case states that prosecution isn't able to paint defendants as gang members or racist in order to stir the jury in capital cases, where the jury acts as judge. Yet the prosecutors did so to convict Kevin to death by prejudice jury.

Help Kevin

Kevin may not receive complete immunity in regards to his participation and he is Man enough to accept consequence for his role with profound remorse.

And since Kevin has proven the State's assumption wrong of him being a "Continuing Threat to Society", for he is constantly bettering himself. For he is not a killer or murder.

Immunity is the aim but is not the only resolution. As there is life without parole in prison, as there he can further rehabilitate.

Kevin's Words

Some people change while some mature. I have to the best of my ability applied myself to both. I've made some good and some bad choices in my lifetime, and it has made me a more conscious man for righteousness. I don't want to die behind what wasn't intentional or out of my control.

Moreover, Kevin has been rejected, on August 21st, from the federal court (the 3rd stage in a 5 stage appeal process). He should get soon a date of execution.

Kevin needs donations for an Attorney, legal Material, and a private investigator. Donations don't necessary mean money ; but assistance in campaigns and protesting for justice and his life.
